

## Proposed Telus Cell Phone Tower at Greenfield Baptist Church

Greenfield Community League has just been notified of plans by Telus to build a covered cell phone tower at the SW corner of 114 Street and 37a Ave NW, on the property of the Greenfield Baptist Church. TELUS is proposing the construction of 25m covered tower to improve coverage along the 111 Street & LRT route, as well as in the communities of Greenfield and Duggan.

Construction will last approximately 45 days, with the intention of having the wireless site operational by December 2011.

TELUS says will compile comments taken from the surveys collected from the Open House and respond to individual surveys with relevant concerns to this proposal. TELUS will prepare a summary of comments and responses then submit it to the City of Edmonton as well as Industry Canada for concurrence.

Telus is required by City policy to consult the community. The city will recommend whether the project should go ahead or not. The final decision lies with Industry Canada.
