- **Tennis:**
 - i. Historically, there was a tennis board that reported to the GFCL board. They led the vision for the tennis club and supervised Chris, monitored his hours. They have slowly lost it. We also didn't get the community enhance grant. Tennis wants to do a \$60k resurfacing. Chris pointed us to Capilano Tennis Club. Tennis simply needs more leadership. We need someone to do some engagement with to understand what Greenfielders want from it. Amanda will be meeting with Tennis Alberta. We need to think about how to get the tennis group to take ownership.
 - ii. Next step: get tennis user data, write an article for Gazette, create an engagement form. Gather feedback from AGM as well. Then decide next steps.
 - iii. Megan to follow up with CFEP staff member on why we didn't get the grant.
 - iv. If needed, cancel/postponed the re-surfacing by AGM.
