Tips for Fall Yard Care

As the weather turns colder and leaves start to fall, it's time to think about getting your yard ready for the winter. Rake Leaves Regularly

Leaves can smother grass, blocking sunlight and trapping moisture which can lead to a host of problems. To prevent this, you should rake your leaves frequently throughout the fall. This will help reduce lawn disease and give your grass a chance to breathe. It's also important to remove any large twigs, sticks or other debris that can get caught in your lawn mower and damage your grass.

Aerate Your Lawn


Aerating your lawn helps to open up compacted soil so that air, water and nutrients can get down into the root zone. Aerating also helps to reduce thatch build-up and encourages more vigorous growth. You can aerate your lawn using either a garden fork or a special aeration machine.

Water Your Lawn

Watering is another important part of fall yard care in Edmonton. You should water your lawn once or twice a week, depending on the weather. Water deeply and less frequently for better results. Deep, infrequent watering encourages grass roots to grow deeper in the soil, which makes them more resilient against cold temperatures and droughts.

With a bit of effort and attention during the fall months, you can ensure that your yard is ready for winter and looking great come next spring!






