With everyone doing it on the same day, the organizers work together to cover signage, advertising and draw more visitors to each garage sale. Many garage sale shoppers flock to Greenfield as it is easier to visit multiple locations in one neighborhood instead of driving all over town.

If you apply to participate, your house/sale will be marked on a map shared with the neighborhood, enabling prospective shoppers to find you and browse your wares!

This is a good opportunity to complete spring cleaning, donate and dispose of any items that didn't make sell at the garage sale, and connect with community residents.

We have partnered with Find Edmonton to have an onsite donation collection team for quality used items that can be diverted from the landfill.

We are also hoping to have some snacks, light refreshments, and hotdogs for sale onsite (weather pending) to raise funds for the community league. If you are not a community league member, we will have memberships available for purchase on site.

**Volunteer Coordinator**: Establishes a network of potential volunteers to help support community initiatives and events. Works closely with the social director.







#### **Japanese Martial Arts**

The Kita Kaze Budo Association is a non-profit organization dedicated to the promotion of Japanese weapon arts in Edmonton, Canada.

Kendo, meaning "way of the sword" in Japanese, is a full-contact sport where practitioners put on armour and strike each other with bamboo swords.

Iaido, the art of cutting a target immediately from the draw and sheathing the katana, utilizes a dull blade while performing special choreographed sequence's called kata.

The Naginata is the Japanese polearm, A full-contact sport comprised of sparring with armour and bamboo weapons as well as kata (choreographed sequences of attack and defense)

#### **Hatha Yoga Classes**


